To place your order:

- 1. Go to <u>https://approve.myfundraisinghub.com/</u> enter the codes supplied on their artwork card and confirm their name and class. You can then approve their artwork.
- 2. Once the artwork is approved you will be directed to the online shop. Click shop now > choose your product > enter the organisation and design code (details are on the leaflet the children are bringing home this week).
- 3. Follow the prompts to complete your order at the checkout. All payments must be made online when you place your order using a credit or debit card, and all orders will be despatched with free delivery to school.
- 4. All orders must be placed by <u>Friday 17th November 11.59pm</u> at which time all orders are sent to print.

Please note if you have a children in the Infants and the Junior school – you will need to place separate orders in the online shop as classfundraising aren't able to mix the different school codes within the same order.
