Dear Parents,

Welcome back to our Year 1 and Year 2 families and a big welcome to all of our new families. This letter contains a lot of information so please bear with us.

This half-term the children will be learning about:

Year 2 – 'What Makes Me Amazing!' We have been talking about what we are good at and what makes us amazing. We will be reading fairy tales in English and will be writing character descriptions and will add more detail when re-writing the stories. In Maths we will be recapping place value and how many tens and ones in a number as well as adding and subtracting 2 numbers. In Art we will be learning about Andy Warhol and creating our own pictures in the style of Andy Warhol.

Year 1 - "Sensational senses". Throughout this term, the children will be looking at different parts of the body and the senses we use every day for touch, smell, taste, sight and listening.

In RHEd, the children will be looking at the emotions and how we deal with our emotions in different situations. In Computing the children will be learning how to log on to the computers safely and about staying safe on line. In Art the children will be looking at the artist Guiseppe Arcimboldo who uses fruit to create self-portraits.
