Year 1

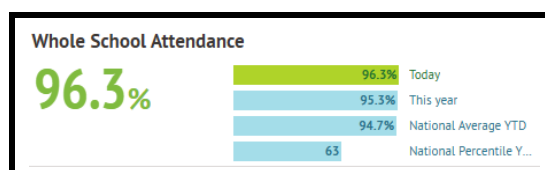

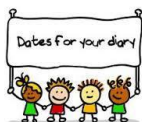


Our film clubs take place on **Wednesday 25th March**.
