Year Group News

Year 2

This week Year 2 have been learning about habitats around the world and the key features of these. In Computing they have been using questions to create binary trees to sort information. Maybe you can make one at home? In English, the children have been learning more about whales, and what they need to help our character Noi look after the whale that he found. In Maths they have been solving worded problems for addition and subtraction.

Year 1

Year One had a fantastic trip to Hillier's Arboretum, where they enjoyed exploring the beautiful surroundings. They took part in a variety of hands-on activities, including pond dipping, leaf matching, and identifying evergreen and deciduous trees. Why not ask your child about the wildlife they discovered during pond dipping? A big thank you to everyone who supported the trip!

This week in Maths, the children have been learning about grouping. They explored what grouping means and developed their understanding through a range of practical activities and resources. In Computing, the children have been learning about representing data in different ways. They explored pictograms and enjoyed creating their own pictograms using Purple Mash.

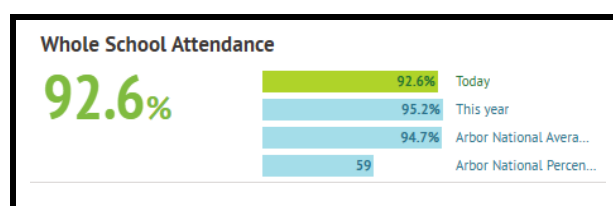
Year R

The children have been asking thoughtful questions and showing great curiosity during their investigations. In Literacy we have been so impressed with the children's growing independence as they work on sentence writing. Their confidence is really shining through. In Maths, the children have been exploring doubling by spotting patterns and using counting to understand what makes a double. Art has been full of creativity this week, with lots of sticking, cutting and collage as the children designed and made their own bear masks. They loved bringing their learning to life through art.

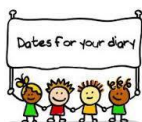
