Year Group News

Year 2

This week Year 2 have been exploring different ways that they could join materials together to make their bag. The children have also started to design their own bag to fit the purpose of carrying their water bottle. In Maths they have been working on telling the time and reading analogue clocks. In English the children have been reading 'The Tin Forest' story and writing descriptions using noun phrases. In PE they have started learning the skills needed for kickball. In myHappyMind the children were thinking about what job they would like to do in the future and what character strengths they would need to be able to do it. Can your child tell you what job they want to do when they are older?

Year 1

Year 1 enjoyed an outdoor learning session this week and explored the Summer environment around them and created their own leaf and bark rubbings, closely observing the textures, patterns, and veins found in leaves. In Computing, the children designed and created their own fairy-tale Bee-Bot mats in preparation for their BeeBot learning. In Maths, the children have been learning about clockwise and anti-clockwise turns. They have been practising these movements using their bodies and spinners to develop their understanding of direction and rotation. Can your child show you how to make a full clockwise turn?

This week Year R have been exploring the Julia Donaldson story 'Tiddler'. In the Art area they have loved junk modelling boats and testing whether they float or sink. A mystery box has arrived in the writing area and they have loved creating their own sentences about what is in the box? Fast and slow tempo has been the focus in Music and they have also loved learning a few pirate songs. Yo ho ho me hearties!

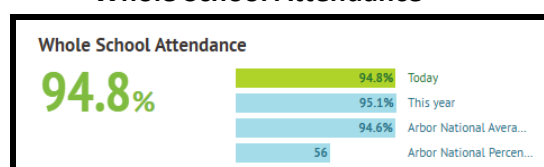
