Year Group News

Year 2

This week Year 2 children have designed and made their bags with the purpose of carrying their water bottles. They worked really hard to make templates, cut the material and use their joining techniques. In English the children wrote a retell of the 'Tin Forest' using great description and time connectives. In Geography the children have been learning about the equator and why it is hotter in countries nearer the equator and colder at the North and South Poles. The children also had their sports day and they all did brilliantly during the different races!

Year 1

This week in Maths, Year 1 have been learning about quarter turns and how to move clockwise and anticlockwise. Ask your child if they can demonstrate a clockwise turn for you! In DT, the children created designs for their fairy-tale moving pictures and came up with lots of imaginative and creative ideas. During Outdoor Learning, the children explored the woodland and sorted natural objects into groups, identifying similarities and differences between them.

Year R

This week Year R has been full of creativity and teamwork! They have loved exploring their new story *The Rainbow Fish*. They have created colourful crabs and beautiful shells. The children have also been busy writing and illustrating their own imaginative stories, showing fantastic effort and growing confidence. We were also very proud of everyone's enthusiasm and determination on our Morning of Sport, where the children did their very best and showed wonderful team work.

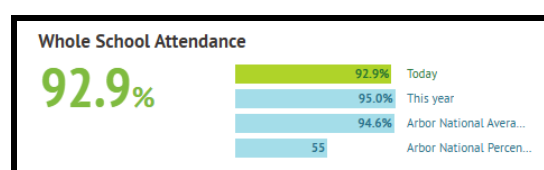
Junior Duke Information

The Hampshire Safeguarding Children Partnership (HSCP) [Water Safety Toolkit](#) for parents offers simple, practical advice to help families stay safe.

The toolkit includes guidance on:

- **Everyday risks at home** – including bath time safety and garden hazards
- **Staying safe outdoors** – such as the beach, around rivers and in open water
- **Practical safety advice** – including the Water Safety Code and how to “Float to Live”
- **Age-specific guidance** – for babies, young children, older children and teenagers
- **What to do in an emergency** – including simple first aid steps and where to find further support
