Basingstoke Discovery Centre – Summer 2026 Reading Challenge

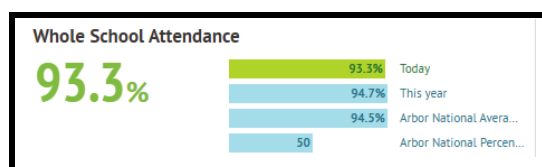
