Christmas Cards – DEADLINE TO ORDER THIS FRIDAY 17th NOVEMBER

The children have each designed their own Christmas cards and by now you should have received a copy of their artwork and details on how to order. Please note the **order deadline is Friday 17th November 11.59pm** to allow time for printing and shipping.

To place your order:

1. Go to <https://approve.myfundraisinghub.com> enter the codes supplied on their artwork card and confirm their name and class. You can then approve their artwork.
2. Once the artwork is approved you will be directed to the online shop. Click shop now > choose your product > enter the organisation and design code (details are on the leaflet the children brought home).
3. Follow the prompts to complete your order at the checkout. All payments must be made online when you place your order using a credit or debit card, and all orders will be despatched with free delivery to school.
4. All orders must be placed by Friday 17th November 11.59pm at which time all orders are sent to print. Please note if you have children in the Infants and the Junior school – you will need to place separate orders in the online shop as class fundraising aren't able to mix the different school codes within the same order.
