Welcome back everyone! We all hope you had a good Easter break. This term:-

Year 2's topic is 'All Around the World'. They will be learning about hot and cold countries, making bags for a journey and researching countries in other continents.

Year One's topic is 'Fabulous Forests'. They will be learning about different plants and trees, a variety of different wildlife and completing a seed investigation in Science. The children will be visiting Hillier's this term to consolidate their learning.

Year R's new topic is Bears. They will be exploring different bear stories and looking at bear habitats. In Science the children will be learning about growing and they will be planting flowers. They are very excited about their trip to Wellington Country Park!

Year 2

This week Year 2 have been talking about their special places and have enjoyed sharing them with others. They have explained why they are special and have drawn pictures of them. In Maths the children have been learning to measure using cm and have been reading scales. The children have started to practise for sports day and had great fun running the relay race! In English, they have listened to the first part of the book they will be reading in lessons and have drawn an image to match it.

This week the children have started looking at the story 'Follow Me Little Fox', exploring the suffix 'ing' and writing a poem about nature. In Maths, the children have been adding two-digit numbers together. They used their observational skills to draw a flower and have labelled part of a plant. In RHEd they have been talking about the meaning of 'special'.

Wow what a busy week! The children have started their new topic all about bears. They had a wonderful time exploring in the woodlands looking for parts of a bear story and observing the beautiful bluebells. They found a broken chair and a bowl and spoon! Can you guess the story? In Art the children have been doing observational drawings of bears and in P.E they have started practicing their races for sports day!
