BOOK YOUR TICKETS TO THE KSA MINI AND JUNIOR DISCOS!

We're so excited to once again be hosting both a mini and junior disco next month. Please save the date for this fantastic event on **Saturday 24th February 2024** at Kempshott Village Hall.

We will be hosting 2 discos on the day to allow for children from both the infant and junior schools to attend.

The first disco of the day will be the Mini Disco, aimed at Infant school children. This runs from 2.30pm – 4pm. Prices per ticket are £3.50 for one adult and one child and any further tickets (for adults or children) are priced at £3.00 per ticket. The price of the ticket includes unlimited squash, a bag of Hharibo and a glow bracelet for the children and a tea/coffee for the accompanying adult.

The second disco of the day is our Junior disco and this takes place between 4.30pm – 6pm. Prices are the same as above (£3.50 for one adult and one child and £3.00 for any subsequent tickets).

Please be reminded that a responsible adult must stay on site with any children attending due to the event happening off the school premises. We cannot take responsibility for any children left unattended and without an accompanying adult, we will unfortunately have to refuse entry.

Both discos are open to children of all ages (Year R – Year 6), so if you have children across both schools, please pick the disco most relevant to you (please be aware however that the mini disco is generally aimed at younger children and the Junior disco is mainly aimed at older children)

There will also be a café on site selling hot dogs, chocolates, crisps and further hot and cold drinks to purchase on the day. A raffle will also be live on the day with a fantastic chance to win some amazing prizes.
