Year R

Year R have been learning their Christmas songs this week! The children have been exploring one more and one less in Maths and have been working hard to learn their numbers. In the shared area they have been working on creating patterns and at the craft table the children have been busy making Percy's friend Fox. In PSEd Year R have been talking about their feelings.

Year 1

This week the children have been looking at plurals in English, creating a shopping list and adding 's' and 'es'. They have also been looking at the features of a letter and writing their own letter, pretending to be Sophie explaining what the tiger has been up to when coming for tea. In Maths, the children have been focusing on place value of numbers in a sequence and partitioning numbers into groups of ten and ones. In Art they have been painting their Diva Pots.

Year 2

Year 2 have had a very busy week. In Maths they have been learning to tell the time to o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to. Some children have begun to learn how to tell the time to the nearest 5 minutes. In English the children were given a set of words from a book. They had to try and predict what the story might be about, where it might be set and who might be in it just by reading a few words from the story e.g. London, soldier, whooshed, lost and strong. They then listened to the story and wrote a book review.

In History, they have enjoyed learning about Victorian children and the jobs they did as well as inventions from the Victorian times.
